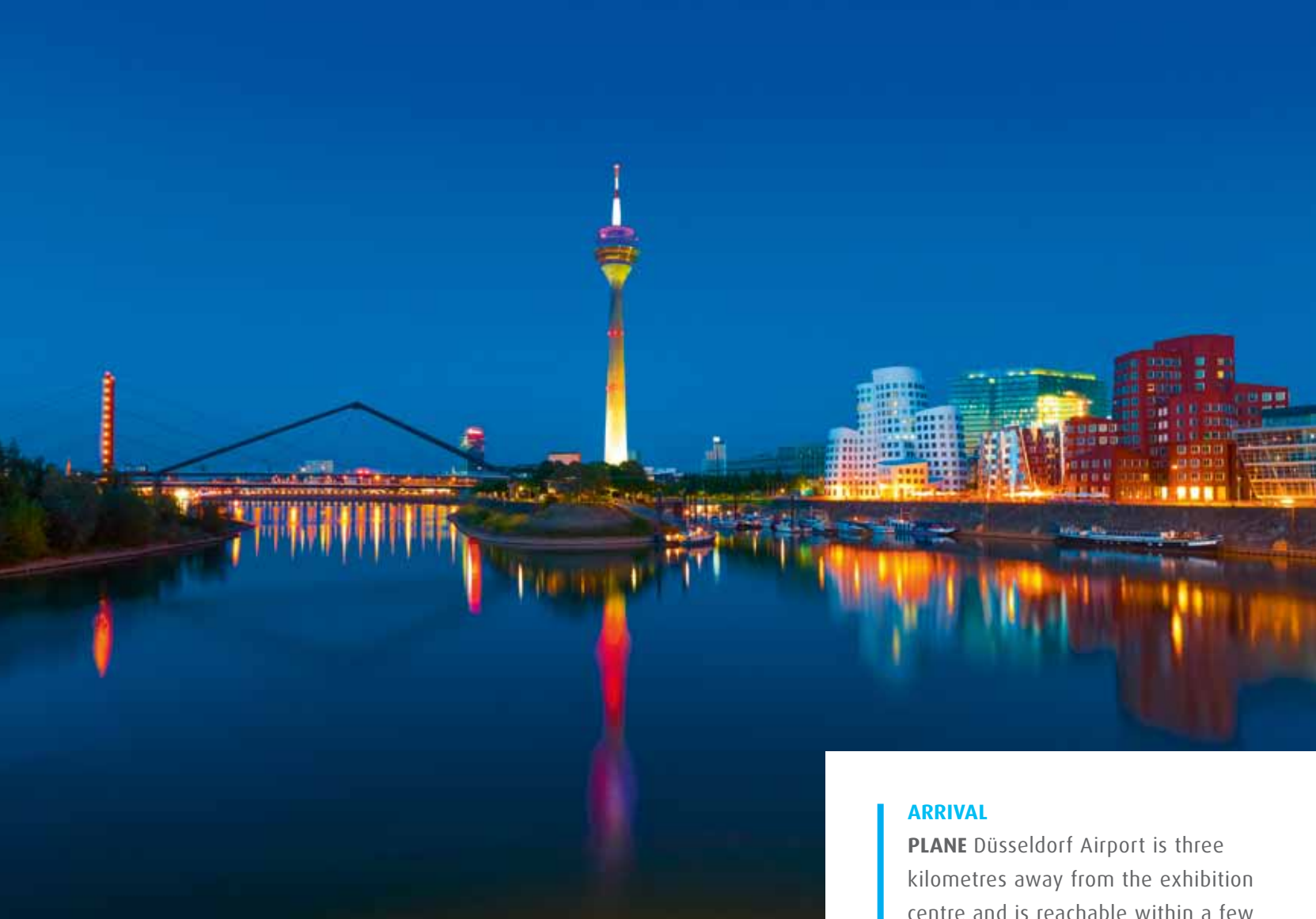

VISITS DÜSSELDORF

ARRIVAL

PLANE Düsseldorf Airport is three kilometres away from the exhibition centre and is reachable within a few minutes by bus number 896 or by taxi. For more information visit www.duesseldorf-international.de

CAR Arrival via the A44 motorway, the signposts for the exhibition lead to the large car parks P1 and P2. From there, free shuttle buses (bus shuttle 897) take you to the exhibition entrances.

TRAIN The main railway station at Konrad-Adenauer-Platz is located in the city centre. From there, the tram lines U78 and U79 will take you to the exhibition centre.
